Waste Management Policy Document

The aim of the energy policy document is to have a clear policy and guidelines for managing the waste generated by the institute and minimize its impact on the environment.

- The institute should assess the waste generated by it and measure its impact on the environment.
- The institute shall follow the 4R policy Reduce, Reuse, Repair and Recycle.
- The waste should be segregated in dry waste and wet waste by installing waste segregation dustbins in the campus.
- E-waste should be collected separately in the institute so that they can be given for recycling.
- The institute shall discourage the usage of single use plastic items like plastic bags, plastics bottles, straws, plastic fork and spoons, etc.
- All individuals (teaching, non-teaching and students) of the institution should carry their own water bottles instead of usingsingle use plastic water bottles.
- Sewer waste discharged from the toilets should be collected in a septic tank for the anaerobic digestion processes of sewage waste.
